

## **Family Rental Policies**

### **1. Conduct, Health and Safety:**

- a. Please supervise children at all times.
- b. All guests must sign a family code of conduct.
- c. Please be respectful of other guests – quiet hours begin at 10pm.
- d. Please don't chase the farm animals if they are out grazing – they help us mow the lawns!
- e. Please maintain social distancing and use facemasks when required. Always have a mask with you.
- f. To keep the guests and staff of Fairview Lake YMCA Camps safe, we ask each family to take responsibility for their health. This includes:
  - i. Monitoring themselves for symptoms of Covid-19 - including fever, cough, loss of taste or smell, or sore throat.
  - ii. Using proper PPE & hand washing techniques as required.
  - iii. Self-selecting out of the program if you believe you were exposed to someone with Covid-19.
- g. Temperatures of each guest will be taken upon arrival at camp, and daily during their stay. An individual with a temperature of 100.4 F or higher will be asked to leave camp. They may return to camp after 72 hours fever free, without using medication to reduce fever.

## **2. Cabins & Grounds**

- a. Please do not store trash outside of your cabin. Trash & Recycling will be picked up each day. Please move it to the center of the unit before breakfast.
- b. Please leave pets home.
- c. Clotheslines will be provided for each cabin.
- d. No cooking inside of cabins. Outdoor grills are permitted.
- e. No indoor candles.
- f. Please park in designated lots only. The speed limit on camp is 10mph.
- g. Driving between units, program areas and the dining hall is not permitted.
- h. Please do not build fires outside of firepits. You may bring your own, or rent one from the Trading Post.
- i. Firepits must be at least 20 feet away from all structures.
- j. Firewood may be purchased at the Trading Post and will be delivered to your cabin.

## **3. Recreation**

- a. Helmets are required for biking, boarding, & skating.
- b. Swimming and boating are ONLY permitted when a lifeguard is present and the waterfront is open.
- c. Please follow posted waterfront rules.
- d. No fishing in swimming or boating areas – fishing at Fairview Lake is catch and release only.

#### **4. In Case of Emergency**

- a. Please remember to sign in and out of camp if you leave the grounds for the day. This will help us know who is on camp in case of an emergency.
- b. During normal business hours, the office will be open.
- c. After hours, please call 973-383-1339 to reach the on-call staff member.

#### **FOR RENT/PURCHASE AT THE TRADING POST**

##### **Campfires:**

- *Firepit*: \$25/Per night – includes one bundle of firewood
- *Additional Firewood*: \$5 per bundle
- Firewood and Firepits will be delivered to your cabin by 4pm.
- *Lighters and Matches* will be available for purchase at the Trading Post too!

##### **Waterfront:**

- *PFDs*: FREE rental for the week. Will be labeled with your cabin number and initials. Please return by Saturday at 10am. Lost or damaged PFDs will be charged to your account.
- *Noodles*: Available for purchase at the Trading Post, or bring your own!

##### **Recreation Items:**

- *Sports Equipment* is available for loan each week. We highly recommend families bring their own. Lost or damaged equipment will be charged to your account.
